


Directions: Proceed down Shirley Highway (Va. 350) to Seminary Road, a partial cloverleaf (4.4 miles from Beltway, 5.3 miles from 14th St. Bridge). Go S.E. on Seminary Road 0.6 mile to N. Howard St., turn left, and go 0.4 mile to Braddock, right 0.2 mile to park entrance. Inside park look for FSGW penants  to guide you.
