We paid but \$452.00 for hall rental, 274. for performers, 20.00 other program costs, 53.00 postage, (mainly for publicity) 317.49 miscalleneous (publicity, platform for picnic, etc:) 593.00 for newsletter which includes postage and miling list expense. Although our income increased so did our expenses and expectations. A motion was made and passed that we sen the newsletter to members by second class mail for an experimental period of time.

Program

To date the Pete Seegar film has not been found. The December program of "Old Time Barn Dance Music and Song" will be held at Pierce Hall on December 9, 1966. Fields Ward and Tony Alderman will be on the program. There will be no performers fees but we will ~~pay~~ pay travel expenses for Fields which should be less than \$25.00.
