VI. ELECTION OF OFFICERS

A.

B. The Nominating Committee shall select a slate of candidates for office and shall report to the membership at the March meeting. *and at the April meeting,* At that meeting, additional nominations for any office may be made and seconded from the floor.

C.

D. *Immediately following the meeting* ~~During the month of April,~~ the membership shall be sent authenticated ~~secret~~ ballots for the election which shall include the names of all candidates for office and space for write-in candidates. The ballots are either to be returned by mail to the Board prior to the ~~June~~ ^{May} meeting, the envelope to be marked "Ballot," or brought to the ~~June~~ ^{May} meeting. At the ~~June~~ ^{May} meeting, the mailed ballots, unopened, and the ballots brought to the meeting, shall be collected and *tabulated* and the results announced. Write-in votes are permitted. Only authenticated ballots sent by mail to the members shall be counted.

E.

F. For each office, the candidate with the most votes shall be elected. In case of a tie, the membership attending the ~~June~~ ^{May} meeting will, by secret ballot, elect between the two candidates. The newly elected officers shall take office as of July 1.
