If we can't work something outshe can at least perform at the Red Fox. Open Sing to be led by Tom McHenry. There will be no open sing in July. Glen Echo plans are coming along well. Libba Cotton is to be added to the schedule. The newsletter schedule is not totally accurate. Final schedule will be available at the festival.
