Welcome to the Getaway! Here are some reminders--

PARENTS: YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR YOUR CHILDREN'S SAFETY.

MEDICAL STAFF is Mia Gardiner and Tom McHenry.
FIRST-AID KIT is located in kitchen.

PARKING is limited; you will probably be told where to park.
Squeeze in tightly as possible. **DO NOT BLOCK FIRE LANES**
at any time.

INSTRUMENT AND OTHER STORAGE is limited to Registration
Office, Nature Lodge behind C Lodge, and your cabin.
Please do not leave personal belongings in Dining Hall.
LOST AND FOUND is in Registration Office.

TELEPHONE for emergency use is located off kitchen. Enter
through door at loading dock; do not go through kitchen.

Area D has been designated for quiet sleeping. Babies are
sleeping in area B.

Remember to **CLEAN UP AFTER YOURSELVES**. This is important,
so we can come back again next year. Do your part. Return
SODA BOTTLES to kitchen loading dock. **DO NOT THROW THEM**
AWAY--they are returnable! Before leaving, sweep your
cabin and put trash in appropriate receptacles.

provided in Dining Hall and Registration Office.
