We are pleased to confirm your participation in the 1982 Summer Dance Series to be held in the Spanish Ballroom at Glen Echo Park. Your group is scheduled as the featured performers on

The Glen Echo Summer Dance Series is co-sponsored by the National Park Service and the Folklore Society of Greater Washington. This letter, when cosigned by you, represents a permit to use the Spanish Ballroom and an agreement to the conditions listed below.

With respect to the program itself, it is understood that you will be providing leadership and planning for the dance as a whole. Specifically,

- .Your group is responsible for providing live music, a person to collect admissions, a caller or instructor and demonstration dancers, if appropriate.
- .The dance will be open to the public and beginners will be welcome.
- .Admission will be \$3.00 (\$2.50 for FSGW members). You will receive the admissions less (1) 20% of the receipts above \$200 which will acrue to the Park and the FSGW, and (2) a \$25 charge is the Parks sound equipment is used. The dance will run from 8:30 until 11:30 pm.

In addition, it is important that the program for which you are responsible is conducted in accordance with Park regulations. Specifically,

- .There can be no alcoholic beverages or smoking in the ballroom during the evening
- .The present ballroom capacity is 300.
- .The ballroom must be left in a clean and orderly condition.

.The National Park Service is not liable for any loss, damage, or claim from the use of the ballroom.
