To promete local country dance and music traditions, and to foster more comunity involvement in these trations, the folklore society is offering to co-sponsor a family dance program with community based organizations such as yours.

A family dance, although varying somewhat with the particular staff, includes squares, contras and circle dances. The dances are normally run where all ages dance to progressively more complex material. No particular skills are required to enjoy oneself and "grown up only" dances may be thrown in on occasion. The ages can range from 9 to 90.
