#### **President's Report:**

• The budget discussion is the primary item for this evening's meeting.

#### **Treasurer's Report:**

- Current account balances as of 8/31/25:
  - o Wells Fargo: \$38,946
  - o Fidelity: \$61,334

- o Vanguard: \$193,048
- Total: \$293,328
- To date this fiscal year, there is a net loss of about 20k. The approved budget was for a loss of about \$29k.
- Joel has access to all the accounts now and is getting up to speed.
- Continuing to work on a dispute with the IRS. The latest response was sent today.

# **Office Report:**

- Mo is back from working at Pinewoods and is more available for meetings as needed. They are working on Washington Folk Festival action items (posting to various calendars, boosting on social media, etc) as well as publicity for Contrastock.
- Troubleshooting a bug with Facebook events.
- Milo has been looking into opt-in vs opt-out for receiving the weekly eblast. *Consensus of the board to switch to an opt-out system.*

#### **ACTION ITEMS:**

#### FY 26 Budget:

- Discussion:
  - O Joel Bluestein outlined the draft budget which is based on input from various committees and organizers and last year's actuals. There are not a lot of big changes from last year. The draft shows a deficit of about \$32,000, which will come out of reserve accounts. The program items just about break even. Dues and donations are not enough to offset expenses, especially staffing.

- O Adjusting membership pricing could significantly impact the budget. That is a potential discussion for the board to have in-depth in the future.
- *Motion:* Joel Bluestein moved, Alyssa Hemler seconded, to approve the V1 FY26 Budget as written. Approved unanimously.

#### **DISCUSSION ITEMS:**

#### **Future FSGW Webmaster:**

- Will Strang's last day in this role was September 1, 2025. Charlie Pilzer is the current point person.
- A notice went in the newsletter and it will go in future eblasts that we are looking for additional support.
- Office staff will work on learning how to process refunds.

#### **Takoma Park Folk Festival:**

• FSGW is sponsoring the Abbot Stage. Lucia will be there to welcome folks and hand out flyers about FSGW and for FSGW's Washington Folk Festival.

## **Washington Folk Festival:**

- The schedule is complete. Ayan and Ingrid are working out the final logistics including volunteer coordination, food trucks, rentals, and staff.
- There is not enough space for all the performers to park at the festival. There will be a limited shuttle for satellite performer parking. This will be an addition to the original event budget.
- Publicity is in full swing including a newsletter article, print and radio ads, and articles in town/community papers.
- To date, we have received \$8,583 in donations and sponsor commitments. Mailings have been sent soliciting additional donations. We should hear the decision about a \$4,000 MSAC grant this week.

### **Update to FSGW Safety Policy:**

• After two strong meetings, this item has lost momentum. Lucia will present the status at the next board meeting and solicit feedback on the new draft public-facing policy.

#### **Support for Board Members:**

• Many board members could use additional support in fulfilling their roles. A notice soliciting volunteers was included in the latest newsletter and will be in future eblasts.

#### New Series: Queer-affirming social dance in Alexandria

- Lucia has found a possible venue: Lyon Village Community House in Clarendon. It is metro accessible and affordable (\$60/hour) and has parking.
- Lucia will put together a more detailed proposal for the next board meeting.

### **FSGW Picnic:**

• Lucia is working on programming finalizing the schedule.
